Recently we have developed the playground with the laying of artificial grass and the renovation of the gazebo area. The children are also loving the **Trim Trail and playground markings**. The wooded area in the school field has had a makeover so that it is ideal for **outdoor learning** - there are plans afoot to make it even more exciting!



Amazing experiences

We seek to inspire our children to achieve in all areas. As we are part of **St Mary's Academy Trust** (a group of 9 local schools) we are able to offer our children some wonderful experiences that would not be possible as a stand-alone school. Amongst others, these include sports days and competitions at the **English Institute of Sport** where they might bump into an Olympian! The children will learn an instrument while they are with us – currently the corridors echo to recorders and they will have a chance to perform at the **Barnsley Music Festival** and at Young Voices in Sheffield. We offer a wide array of trips to enhance learning and these are enriched further by events such as **residential** and **theatre trips**.



There is a full program of **extra-curricular activities** which include sports activities, choir and even model building. We have a fantastic **Breakfast Club** and also an initiative where we provide every child with a free bagel at the start of the school day.
