'Best show yet, absolutely sterling performance! Great singing - children behaved beautifully, I was literally moved to tears at 'Away in a manger.'


CHRISTMAS SERVICE IN CHURCH

If your child is not wearing any part of their school uniform they will lose a playtime as a consequence.


Pantomime:
