We would like to thank Mrs Shepherd-Woodall for all her hard work and commitment to the school and wish her and her family well for the future.

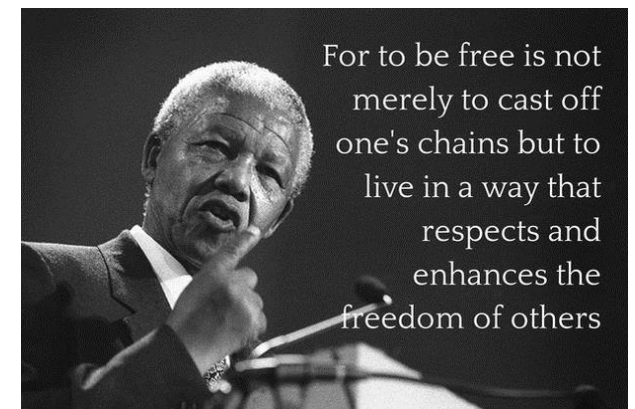
We would also like to welcome Mr Kettle who joined us last week and will be with
